	HKBAC is actively seeking ways to introduce greener initiatives, in particular the provision of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) and have been working closely with Airport Authority Hong Kong (AAHK) on how to provision this service in Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA). AAHK themselves have been working with fuel suppliers to procure SAF for trial flights via Airlines in 2022 and we hope that this will enable SAF to be brought into HKIA in the near future after an initial positive trial.
	HKBAC has the technical and operational capacity to support this emerging change and will ensure we can fulfil our customer's needs once available. In addition, we are working with our fuel suppliers to provide options for Carbon Offsetting Programs which can allow our customers to uplift fuel and offset their carbon emissions prior to SAF being fully available in HKIA. This will enable customers to comply with any applicable Carbon Emission requirements.
